DESCRIPTION

The main aim of this programme is to widen the awareness of cyber resilience and develop a strong pool of talent skilled in cybersecurity so that resilience to online and digital threats can be improved.

There is a great need to develop the skills of the students needed to be safe and resilient in their online lives. In the digital age youth use cyberspace for various goals, also for education. It is important that they will be enabled to get the "basics" right, and take a preventative approach to help themselves stay safe online. It is also vital that they will know what to do if they are subject to an online attack so that they can get back up and running safely. We need therefore to encourage basic cyber awareness and readiness in student's everyday use of digital technologies.

The participants will gain knowledge in the following topics:

- developing cyber resilience through awareness raising and engagement,
- recognizing and responding to digital threats (cyber-attacks and incidents),
- identifying the most significant security trends, defining a secure IT environment, assessing your current gaps, and determining an implementation framework,
- strengthening cyber resilience by responsible communication, critical thinking and creativity.

PROGRAM (3 ECTS)

5-9th June 2023 – 20 hours of virtual mobility

Challenges of the digital technologies.

Digital threats: cyber-attacks and incidents, violence in cyberspace, cyberbullying.

Cybersecurity and current gaps in securing IT environment.

3-7th July 2023 – 40 hours of physical mobility (Bydgoszcz, Poland)

Strengthening cyber resilience by responsible communication, critical thinking and creativity.

10-12th July 2023 – 10 hours of virtual mobility

Training summary, discussion, conclusions.

To participate in this project the students must be enrolled by their universities as **short term mobility** (for physical mobility to Bydgoszcz).
